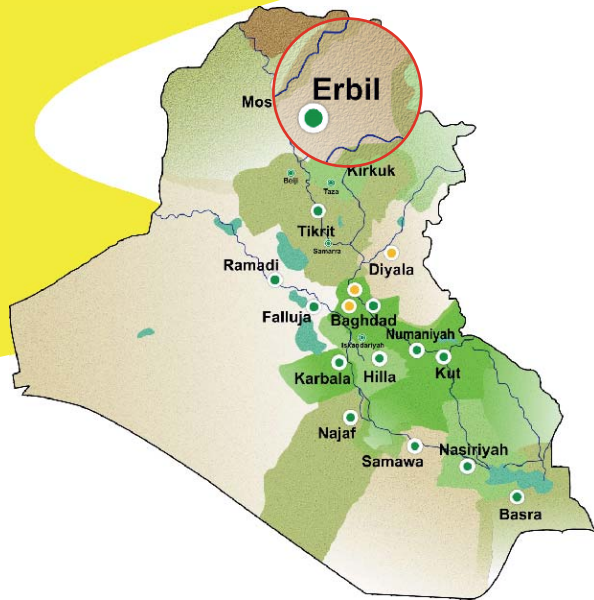
### Our Mission:

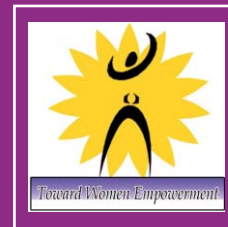
